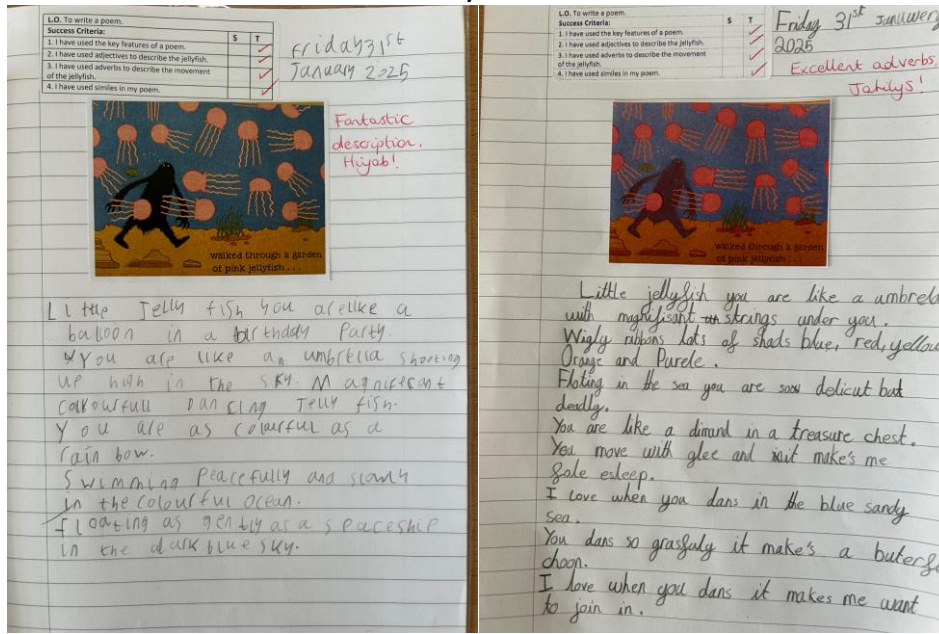


**Auction Night!!**

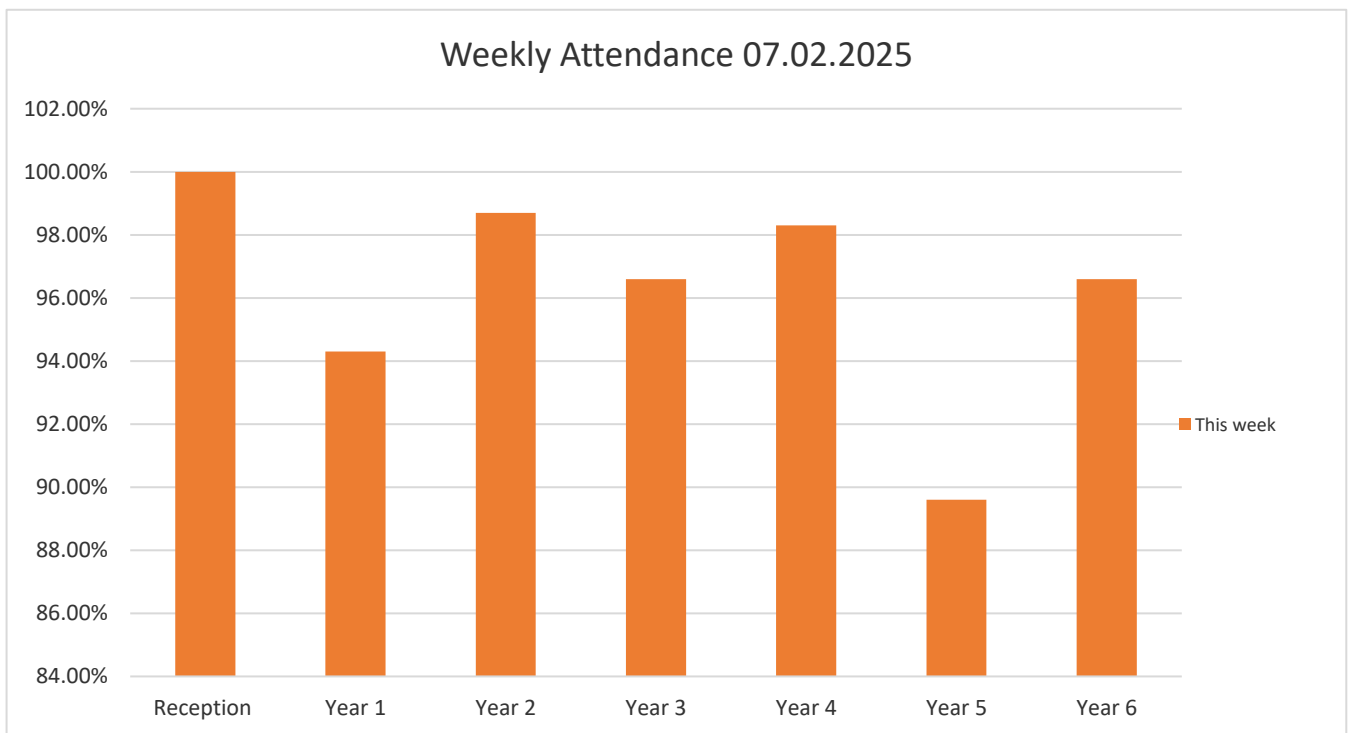
